Discussion Questions

1. Do you think Serena takes the Tempting Fate list her teacher assigns seriously? Why or why not?
2. Describe the ways Serena and Kori are similar and the ways they are different. Why does Serena want to be more like her best friend?
3. Discuss the ways Serena relies on her friendship with Kori. How does this make losing Kori harder?
4. Serena says that she feels paralyzed when she loses Kori. What areas in Serena's life does she put on hold and why?
5. Serena feels like Kori's life was cut too short and that there were things she needed to finish. In what ways does Serena attempt to complete Kori's life? Does she do them the way Kori would have or does she do them in her own way? Explain.
